


"Stanley's Garage"

Join Stanley on another of his adventures. Bold illustrations and simple text ask the reader to respond in this silly series about a guinea pig.




"What James Likes Best"

James takes different types of transportation to visit different people. At the end of each vignette, the reader's opinion of what James liked best is asked.




"Choo Choo Clickety-Clack!"

There are lots of different vehicles to learn about. They all have something they are good at and they all make their own sound!




"Who Is Driving?"

Animals and vehicles abound in this text. Try to guess which animal will be driving what. Where are they all going? Let's find out!




"Wake Up Engines"


"Truck Stop"

A family owns a truck stop and sees the same people every morning for breakfast. But today they haven't seen Green Gus! Where could he be?




"Public Transportation" series
