


"Bark, George"

George's mom asks him to bark, but his responses are noises that other animals make. What's wrong with George?! His mom brings him to the doctor, so hopefully they can figure out what's up.




"Click, Clack, Moo: Cows That Type"

Farmer Brown's cows are cold in the barn, so they start leaving him typed notes asking for electric blankets. When the chickens join in, will he listen?




"Kitten's First Full Moon"

Kitten sees what she thinks is a huge bowl of milk in the sky. As hard as she tries, she just can't seem to reach it though. Will she find a bowl of milk?




"Swimmy"


"I'm the Biggest Thing in the Ocean"
