Program Descriptions

Babies and Books (up to 24 months)

This language-enrichment program features songs, movement, books, and bubbles, followed by an optional parent meet-and-greet time. *No registration required.*

Little Bookworms (Ages infant-5)

Bring your young animal lovers to the Nevins Farm MSPCA, where they will listen to stories and meet animal friends. *No registration required.*

Rockabye Beats (Ages infant-6)

Come sing, dance, and get a little loco with musician and educator Marcos Valles, who has a wonderful knack for connecting with children through music.

Read and Play (Ages 2-5)

Your preschoolers will enjoy this fun half hour of stories, songs, and activities that encourage a love of books.

Bilingual Playgroup (Ages 3-5)

Enjoy this bilingual English/Spanish storytime presented by our community partner, the Coordinated Family & Community Engagement program (CFCE).

Ask a Vet: How to Choose and Care for a Pet (Ages 3-8)

Have your children been begging for a pet? Bring them to this program with a local veterinarian, who can help them think about what kind of pet they want and what's involved in being a responsible, loving pet owner.

Beloved Books (Ages 3-8)

Everyone has favorite books, authors, illustrators, and story characters — in this storytime, children listen to stories, play games, and make crafts that focus on a different favorite each month.

Family Storytime (Ages 3-8)

Wrap up your day with your children at this evening storytime, where they listen to stories, play a game, and make a craft.

Featuring a cast of colorful puppets and fun audience participation, this lively show offers a humorous adaptation of an old legend.
