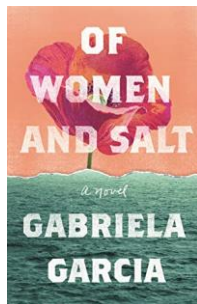


INTRODUCING: The WORDS Book Group (We Only Read Diverse Stories)

This book group will focus on authors and stories that explore diverse and underrepresented voices and experiences.



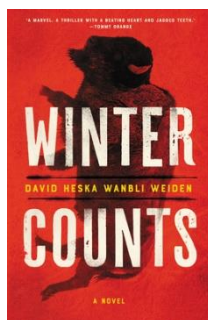
January 11: **OF WOMEN AND SALT** by Gabriela Garcia
