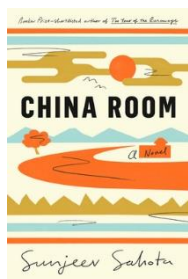


## INTRODUCING: The WORDS Book Group (We Only Read Diverse Stories)

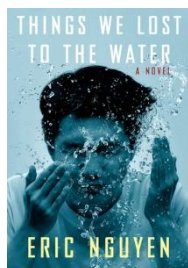
### September 13: *The Hacienda* by Isabel Cañas
