

## **How It Works**

- 1) Register as a participant in the Nevins Library Summer Programs and track your reading progress at: <a href="https://nevinslibrary.beanstack.com/reader365">https://nevinslibrary.beanstack.com/reader365</a>.
- 2) Complete activities to earn points.
- 3) Once you've completed activities, head to the Youth Services Department at the Nevins Library to collect your beads and enter into the end of summer raffle.

### **Bead Bonanza**

Each bead is earned by both reading/listening to a book for 20 minutes and doing 15 minutes of math.

#### You can also collect weekly prizes!

Kick-off Week (6/20-6/24)	Brag Tag, beading necklace, and activity packet. Starting tracking your activities this week!
Weeks 2–8 (6/26-8/14)	1 bead per activity and 1 weekly raffle ticket. PLUS! I special themed bead each week, just for visiting the Nevins Library Youth Services Department desk! You can collect beads until the first day of school!



#### Using the Beanstack online tracking log

- Keep track of all family members' activity logs, progress, and badges on one account. The person who creates the account ("Account Creator") registers themselves and then registers each participating child.
- Log activities from home or on the go to earn digital badges for Bead Bonanza activities:
  - o Go to the Library's Beanstack URL: <a href="https://nevinslibrary.beanstack.org">https://nevinslibrary.beanstack.org</a>. (Beanstack is also available as an Apple or Google app.)
  - o Choose the Summer Activities Log.
- Click on the "Add to Log" button when you are ready to log reading or activities
- If an account has more than one Reader, you will be asked which account you wish to log under; choose the appropriate Reader's account, then choose whether you are logging reading or an activity. Enter your information, then click the "Log" button and watch for the colored band at the bottom of the screen that indicates successful logging.
- To see program information (badges and reading), click on the "Program" link at the top of the screen.
  - o A green bar near the top will show what percentage of the program has been completed.
  - Scroll down until you see the heading "Logging Badges," where you'll see how many books have been logged and the available badges that can or have already been earned. (Each badge starts as a black and white image and becomes a color image once the badge is earned.)

If you choose to track progress using Beanstack, you still have to visit the Nevins Youth Services Department to collect beads and enter into weekly prize raffles.
