

Seeking Searles/Tenney/Methuen High School Yearbooks

The Nevins Library is working with the Library of the Commonwealth at the Boston Public Library to take materials related to Methuen history and scan and digitize them to make these documents readily available to the public on-line. The first project we are undertaking is the digitization of as many Methuen High School yearbooks as we can find. With the assistance of Ms. Paula Cross from the MHS Library/Media Center, and Mr. Arthur Nicholson, Special Projects Adminstrator for the Methuen Public Schools, we have located 75 Yearbooks from Methuen High School (including the Searles & Tenney High Schools), beginning in 1928, and ending in 2012. We are missing ten yearbooks from this period, and are appealing for help from the public to help us fill in those gaps! Did you graduate, or do you know someone from one of the following classes? If so, do they have a yearbook in good condition? 
Dig Into Reading[™] is the 2013 summer reading theme for children (Pre-K to 6th grade). **Children can create their online summer**
