Program Descriptions

Books & Bubbles (Ages infant-18 mos.) This language-enrichment program features songs, stories, and everyone's favorite finale: bubbles! **No registration** required.

Stories & Songs (Ages infant-5) This is an entertaining evening option for families with young children – join us for stories, music, and fun! **No registration** required.

Sensory Monday (Ages 18 mos.-3) This program gives young patrons fun ways to engage their senses with various tactile experiences.

Tales for 2s (Age 2) Here's a program for our young patrons who are "aging out of" Books & Bubbles" – so you can experience the fun and structure of storytimes together, including making a craft!

Read & Play (Ages 2-5) Bring your little kids to this outdoor storytime, where they can enjoy fresh air, stories, and activities on the library's beautiful grounds. No registration required.

Messy Art (Ages 3-5) Kids enjoy this art program where they can have fun creating without worrying about making a mess!

Family Storytime (Ages 3-8) Wrap up your day with your kids at this evening storytime, where they listen to stories and make a craft.

Bilingual Storytime (Ages 3-8) Kids enjoy this storytime in Spanish and English, plus a craft. The program is co-presented with the Greater Lawrence Community Action Council.

Read to Murphy the Dog! (Ages 5-18) Sign up your children for a 10-minute session reading to Murphy the Dog, and build their enjoyment of and confidence in reading.

Story & Craft (Ages 6-8) Here's an evening option for 6-8 year-olds – join us for read-alouds and a craft!

Outside Art (Ages 6-8) We'll try different mediums in this art program – just be sure your kids wear clothes that they don't mind getting messy!

Summer Science (Ages 8-11) Elementary schoolaged kids will enjoy hands-on science activities in this engaging program.

History Unlocked (Ages 8-11) Our "Unlocked" series takes a deep dive into a variety of interesting topics, including hands-on experiences.

Tie-Dye Your Socks! (Ages 8-12) Sign up your kids for this fun program, where they can tie-dye a pair of their socks!

Rock Painting (Ages 8-13) Have your kids seen our Kindness Rocks Garden? Would they like to contribute beautiful art and meaningful messages to this special spot? Register them for this program, where we'll provide paint and rocks for them to decorate.

Create, Explore & More! (Ages 9-11) Each month this program offers activities that engage kids in fun learning and creativity – so many ways to enjoy science, art & self-expression!

Capture the Flag (Ages 12-18) The library's huge lawn is perfect for a game of Capture the Flag – tweens and teens are invited to join us for the fun!

LEGO Block Party (All ages) This program is open to all ages, and we encourage families to come build and create together (using our big supply of LEGOs)

OFFSITE Little Bookworms at the Nevins Farm MSPCA (All ages) Bring your young animal lovers to this program at the Nevins Farm MSPCA, where they will listen to stories and meet animals.

SPECIAL EVENT Kickoff to Kindergarten (For children entering kindergarten in the fall, and their families) Do you have children entering kindergarten in the fall? Bring them to this community fair, which helps children and their families prepare for starting off in the Methuen Public Schools. Hear a story, meet the superintendent, learn about local agencies and organizations, climb on a school bus, and more!

SPECIAL EVENT Didgeridoo Down Under

(All ages) The didgeridoo, usually a hollow tree trunk, is a musical instrument that has been played by Aboriginal Australians for at least 1,500 years and is known for its otherworldly sound. But this program is more than music – it's a high-energy, interactive show that also features comedy, science, Aussie culture, and audience participation!
