

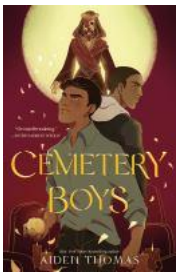
FOREVER YOUNGISH BOOK CLUB 2025-2026 SCHEDULE

NOVEMBER 20- Darkly by Marisha Pessl



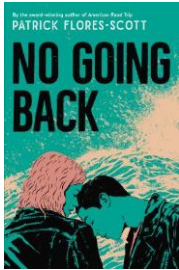
When high schooler Arcadia unexpectedly secures the notorious game-maker's internship, she and the other interns become players in the most twisted game yet.

JANUARY 15- No Going Back by Patrick Flores-Scott



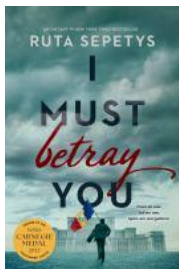

FEBRUARY 19- As Long as the Lemon Tree Grows by Zoulfa Katouh



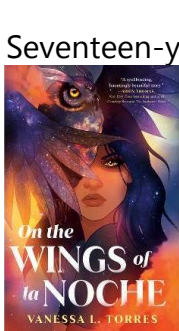

MARCH 19- I Must Betray You by Ruta Sepetys



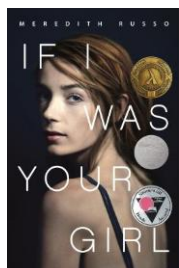
