Program Descriptions

Books & Bubbles (Ages infant-18 mos.) This language-enrichment program features songs, stories, and everyone's favorite finale: bubbles! After the stories and bubbles, patrons are welcome to stay and enjoy a sensory playtime with their little ones. Registration requested but not required.

Stories & Songs (Ages infant-5) This fun evening option for young children includes stories, music, and fun! Registration requested but not required. *Copresented with the Greater Lawrence Community Action Council.*

Read & Play (Ages 18 mos.-4) Bring your kids to enjoy stories, music, and a free-play session using an array of costume, toys, and building materials. Registration requested but not required.

Tales for Toddlers (Ages 2-3) Here's a program for youngsters who are "aging out of" Books & Bubbles, so you can experience the fun and structure of storytimes together (including crafts)!

Big Sibling Storytime (Ages 2-6) Parents, do you have young children who have just become big siblings (or will soon)? Bring them to this program, where we'll read stories and give them a surprise to celebrate being a big sibling! (This session is for children who have not attended previous Big Sibling Storytimes.) *This program is part of our Growing Readers initiative, generously supported by the Castle Fund of Methuen.*

Sprouting Scientists (Ages 3-5) This program is a wonderful opportunity for caregivers and children to explore science together, with stories and hands-on activities that show how engaging science can be.

Donuts with Grown-Ups (Ages 3-8) Children and their adult caregivers are invited to this tasty storytime to enjoy stories, crafts, and donuts!

Family Storytime (Ages 3-8) Wrap up your day with your kids at this evening storytime, where they listen to stories and make a craft.

Spanish/English Bilingual Storytime (Ages 3-8) Kids enjoy this bilingual storytime and craft. *Copresented with the Greater Lawrence Community Action Council.*

French/English Bilingual Storytime (Ages 3-8) Bring your kids to this storytime in French and English, which includes making a craft!

Book Bonding: Caretaker/Child Book Group (Ages 5-7) In this relaxed program you and your child will read a book of your choice together, then come to the meeting to tell other participants about the book and hear about what they have read!

Read to Murphy the Dog! (Ages 5-18) Sign your child up for a 10-minute session reading to Murphy, and build their enjoyment and confidence in reading!

Pokemon Club (Ages 8-10) Do your kids enjoy playing the Pokemon Trading Card Game, or would they like to learn it? This new program accommodates all levels of experience with the game, including instructions for beginners. *(Participants should bring their own cards, but no trading is allowed during the program.)*

Story Solvers (Ages 8-11) In this unique STEM program, kids create concrete solutions to storybook predicaments.

History Unlocked (Ages 8-11) This series takes a deep dive into interesting topics each month.

Page Turners Book Group (Ages 8-11) Are your kids reading great books on their own but are too young for our YA book groups? Try out this program, where they'll help choose the books they'll read, enjoy snacks, and earn incentives from Texas Roadhouse!

Slime of the Month (Ages 9-11) Who knew there were so many kinds of slime you can make? Kids will enjoy producing a different variety each month!

Beads & Baubles (Ages 10-13) Kids can use our huge supply of beads to craft a different item each month.

DIY Designs (Ages 10-13) Every month we'll make another unique craft together!

Make Your Own Zine! (Ages 11-14) At this workshop we'll provide supplies for kids to create their own zines — small folded publications that can be stories, poetry, informational, or whatever inspires them!

Book Babble (Ages 12-18) If your teens love books and just can't stop talking about the last one they read, then this is the group for them!

Teen Gaming Club (Ages 12-18) At this fun program teens can learn new board and card games, play familiar favorites, or use our Nintendo Switch.

Teen Arts & Crafts Club (Ages 12-18) Teens can drop in to create what they like with our craft materials.

Teen Anime Club (Ages 13-18) If your teens are fans of anime or just curious about it, then they'll enjoy this club where they watch and discuss their favorite anime, draw manga, or just hang out.

Teen Movie Club (Ages 13-18) Do your teens love movies? They should come to this program to watch and talk about films — and even help choose the movie!

LEGO Block Party (All ages) This program is open to all ages, and we encourage families to come build and create together (using our huge supply of LEGOs)!

Dinner & a Movie: Wicked for Good (All ages) Join us for a special screening of this epic story's conclusion, and bring dinner to eat while you enjoy the show!

New Parent Meet-Up Are you a new (or new-ish) parent? Join us with your little ones for a relaxed meet-up designed for caregivers of youngsters up to 18 months old — connect with others in the community, share experiences, and build your support network in a friendly, welcoming space.
